



MIKUMI NATIONAL PARK

Mikumi National Park, Tanzania's fourth-largest protected area, covers approximately 3,230 km² and plays a vital ecological role as a wildlife corridor connecting to the vast Nyerere National Park (formerly Selous Game Reserve) in the south. Historically, this region was home to nomadic communities and formed part of an ancient trade route between the interior and the Swahili coast.

Established to conserve the Mkata River floodplains, the park is renowned for its open landscapes, which attract large herds of wildlife especially during the dry season.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Ideal for spotting large herds of elephants, giraffes, buffalo, and predators such as lions and hyenas.
- Tree-Climbing Lions, one of the few places in Tanzania to see this rare behavior.
- Uluguru Mountains' majestic backdrops and perfect for scenic photography.
- Birdwatching Paradise with over 400 recorded species.
- Several hiking trails and waterfalls to explore in and around Mikumi region.
